with the provisions of the Act and shall reclaim all affected lands covered by the original, renewed, or modified
permit in accordance with the Act and plan for reclamation approved by the Department, then this Obligation
shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

The Surety may cancel this bond at any time by filing with the Department ninety (90) days' written notice of
its desire to be relieved of liability provided, however, that this bond shall not be canceled and shall continue in
full force and effect with respect to lands covered by the permit which have become affected lands under the
provisions of the Act prior to the expiration of the ninety (90) days' notice period.

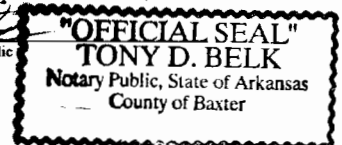

LEASE AND CONTRACT FOR SAND, GRAVEL, AND TOP SOIL

This agreement made this 17th day of March, 2010, by and between Guy King and Sons, Inc. (an Arkansas Corporation), herein referred to as OPERATOR, and Darlene Ott and Alma Smith, hereafter referred to as LESSOR, is as follows:

Whereas LESSOR desires to lease a portion of land for the purpose of mining and sale of sand, gravel, and top soil. Said land is described as follows: Section 1; Township 18 North; Range 16 West. And

Whereas LESSOR understands the operator's methods and plans for the mining and removal of said materials, and

Whereas OPERATOR desires to lease said land and mine said sand, gravel, and top soil materials, and

Whereas OPERATOR is in the business of mining and hauling said materials;

In consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreement contained herein, and good and valuable consideration paid in hand, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1. LESSOR warrants that he has good title and ownership to the land and material to be mined and sold and that he will protect and hold harmless the OPERATOR from claims arising in regard to title and ownership.
2. LESSOR warrants that he is desirous of the OPERATOR to begin excavation, hauling, and other tasks to consummate the mining and removal of materials at the earliest date.
3. LESSOR shall charge and OPERATOR shall pay a royalty for materials removed from the site at a fixed dollar rate per ton of 2,000 pounds or by other methods as shall be agreed upon from time to time. Said rate shall be documented in a letter agreed to by both parties, and said rate shall be made a part of this agreement.
4. LESSOR shall provide access and road right-of-way across his own property to the site without additional charge or fee. Said road and right-of-way shall be in a location agreeable to both parties.
5. OPERATOR shall perform all work of development, production, and maintenance of the site and necessary haul and access roads at the OPERATOR'S own expense.
6. OPERATOR shall obtain all necessary permits and licenses from state and federal regulatory authorities at the OPERATOR'S own expense. OPERATOR shall be responsible for the maintenance of said permits and licenses at its own expense.
7. OPERATOR shall carry suitable Property, Public Liability, and Workman's Compensation Insurance covering OPERATOR'S activities. It is further understood and agreed that the OPERATOR will indemnify and hold harmless the LESSOR for losses, damages, and liabilities which arise from such injuries or damages to persons or property arising from the conducting of operations.
8. OPERATOR shall pay by the 15th of the month for all materials removed and purchased during the preceding month. OPERATOR further agrees to pay all severance taxes that may be due for the material removed from the site.

9. Subject to the conditions of the required reclamation plans approved by regulatory authorities, OPERATOR will leave the site in a drained but otherwise unvegetated and unreclaimed condition when temporary stoppage of mining occurs due to weather or operators decision to hold mining practices in the mining area for the short term.

10. Subject to the conditions of the required reclamation plans approved by regulatory authorities, OPERATOR will leave all roads in an open and unreclaimed state to accommodate the LESSOR'S desire to utilize the roads in the conduct of business in the management of the property.

11. OPERATOR shall be able to abandon operations at any time without further obligation to the LESSOR, except as provided in the permit and license conditions for reclamation and closing of the operation.

12. This Agreement shall be in effect for a five year period beginning with the contract date above. After the expiration of this five year period, OPERATOR and LESSOR shall have the option of renewing this agreement for successive periods of one year upon terms mutually agreeable to both parties.

13. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas.

14. If any provisions of this Agreement shall be determined to be unenforceable or illegal by any court of law, then the remaining provisions shall remain enforceable.

15. The failure of a party to this Agreement to object to or to take action with respect to an conduct of the other party which is in violation of the terms hereof shall not be construed as a waiver of any rights the non-objecting party may have, nor of any future claim of breach or wrongful act.


16. This Agreement shall be binding on the LESSOR/LESSORS, their heirs, successors, and assigns, forever.

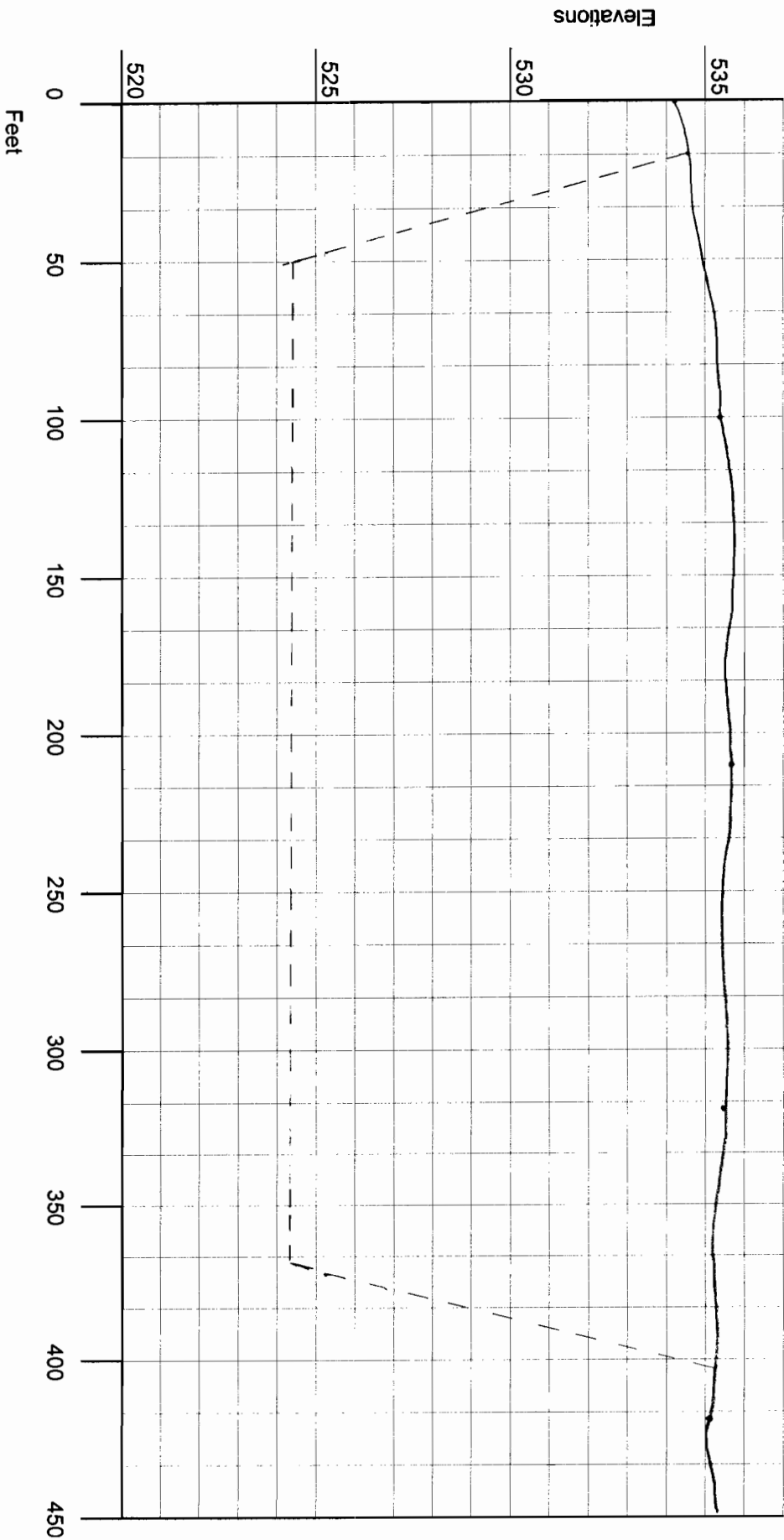

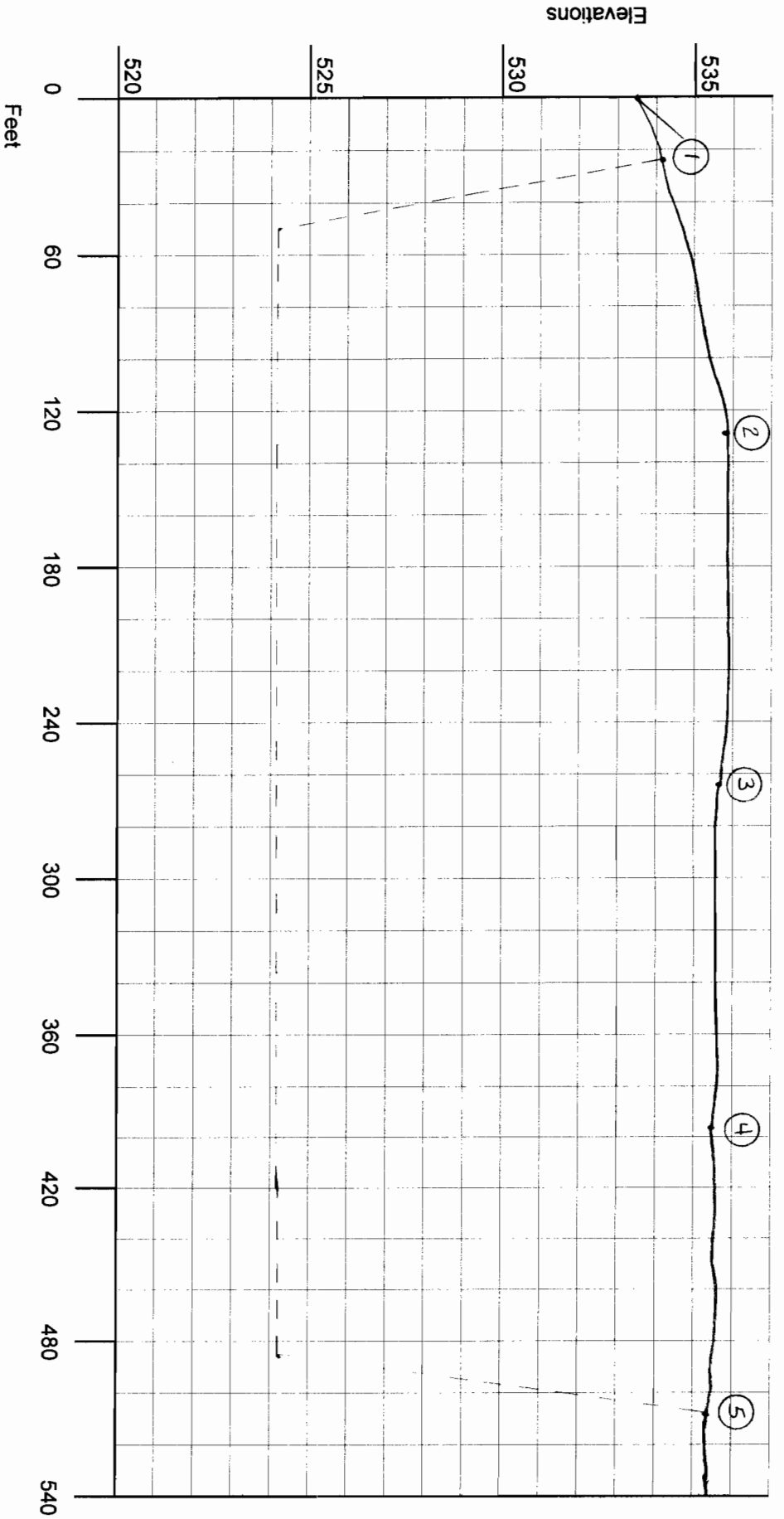
Cross Section B

Mine Plan

The site is located on a private drive off of Mill Creek Road in Marion County. The site entrance will have a cable or gate to restrict entrance. The entrance will also have the permit number, company name and warning signs posted. The permit boundary will have the warning signs posted on 100 foot to 150 foot intervals. The site will be mined by starting in the northwest corner of the site and mined to the east and south. The current elevations are relatively flat which are indicated by the elevations taken of the mine site. This can be seen in the cross sections. Along the permit boundary the slope will be no greater than a 3 to 1 and due to the mixture of soil and gravel material the slopes will maintain a natural vegetative cover of grass and weeds. Topsoil will be removed and stored along the north end of the site and will be used during the reclamation of the land. As indicated early the soil mixture at this site provides good vegetation and a large stockpile of topsoil will not be required for reclamation. However, as a precautionary measure some will be stored. Additional topsoil will be hauled from the site to the processing plant located in Mountain Home, Arkansas. Sand and gravel will be mined from the site to an approximate depth of 10 to 12 feet. The material will be removed from the site and no on site processing will occur. All mining will occur with the use of trackhoes, loaders and dump trucks. There will be no fuel storage on site and all equipment will be fueled from the fuel truck. There will be no water runoff all stormwater will be contained on site. Therefore not storm water permit will be required. The site map and location map are attached to aid in the mine plan and mine location.

Reclamation Plan

The site will be reclaimed once the 4.51 acres have been mined. The reclamation will begin in the northwest corner of the site and move to the south and east. The slopes around the permit boundary will not exceed three to one. Once the slopes have been graded the topsoil stored near the permit boundary will be used to dress the slopes. Should the stored topsoil not be required on the slope then it will be loaded into trucks and hauled to our plant for processing. This stored material will not be removed until the site has been reclaimed and ground cover has been established on site. The reclamation will be done with the use of a bulldozer. If a majority of the reclamation is completed during the winter months the topsoil will not be used until the spring in order to allow for germination of fescue, Bermuda, and rye seed which will be used to seed the site. The seeding rates will be based off of the manufactures recommendations for pounds per acre for pasture lands. These seeds are common to the area and all have demonstrated an ability to survive and flourish in the type of soil and environment. If needed a soil analysis can be performed to identify the soil amendments that will be needed. Upon initial reclamation of the site an additional inspection of the site will be preformed in late spring or early summer to determine if proper ground coverage has been obtained for the site. A second seeding application may be required if a minimum of 70% ground cover has not been obtained on the initial seeding application. The haul road will be graded smooth and remain in place for the owner's personal use after the site is reclaimed. The site is currently used as marginal farm land and will most likely be used as marginal farm land post reclamation. A reclamation map is attached for your records.

- (B) Applicants for a general permit to be issued by the department pursuant to its authority to implement the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System for storm water discharge.
- (C) If the applicant is a publicly held company required to file periodic reports under the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934 or a wholly owned subsidiary of a publicly held company, the applicant shall not be required to submit a disclosure statement, but shall submit the most recent annual and quarterly reports required by the Securities and Exchange Commission which provide information regarding legal proceedings in which the applicant has been involved.
